REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT APPLICATION

THIS APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED AND FILED WITH THE Alcohol Beverage Board when requesting a Refillable Container Permit under Article 2B, § 8-219.1.

The Board will consider your application at their Board Meeting on _____, at 1:00 pm, at the Governmental Center, Chesapeake Bldg., 41770 Baldrige St., Leonardtown, in the BOCC Meeting Room. Upon approval you must bring your current license to the Alcohol Beverage Board Office to be revised.

I/We fully understand that the following privileges and requirements are conferred on holders of a Refillable Container Permit:

1. The hours for sale for a refillable container permit begin at the same time as those for the underlying alcoholic beverages license and end at midnight.
2. The license holder or an employee of the license holder may not allow an individual who is under 21 years old or who is visibly under the influence of an alcoholic beverage the privilege of purchase as authorized by this permit.
3. This permit entitles the holder of a Class A, B (restaurant), or D License to sell draft beer for consumption off the licensed premises in a refillable container that meets the standards under Article 2B §21-107:
 - (A) *This section governs the standards for and use of containers that may be sold, filled, and refilled under the authority of a refillable container permit issued under this article.*
 - (B) *To be used as a refillable container for beer under the authority of a refillable container permit issued under this article, a container shall:*
 - (1) *have a capacity of not less than 32 ounces and not more than 128 ounces;*
 - (2) *be sealable;*
 - (3) *be branded with an identifying mark of the seller of the container;*
 - (4) *bear the federal health warning statement required for containers of alcoholic beverages under 27 C.F.R. 16.21;*
 - (5) *display instructions for cleaning the container; and*
 - (6) *bear a label stating that:*
 - (I) *cleaning the container is the responsibility of the consumer;*
4. In addition to those standards, the refillable container must be sealed by a tamper-proof seal after it is filled/refilled by the licensee and remain sealed at all times while on the licensed premises. A tamper-proof seal may include, but is not limited to the following: a plastic adhesive, tamper resistant tape, a shrink-wrap seal and shrink bands (also known as cut shrink bands, custom cut bands, tamper evident bands, tamper evident seals, safety seals, cap bands, clear bands and seamless bands).
